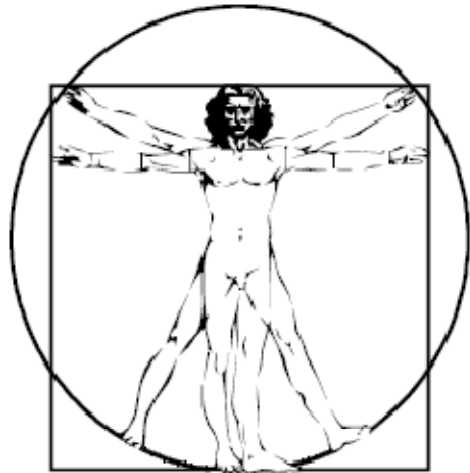

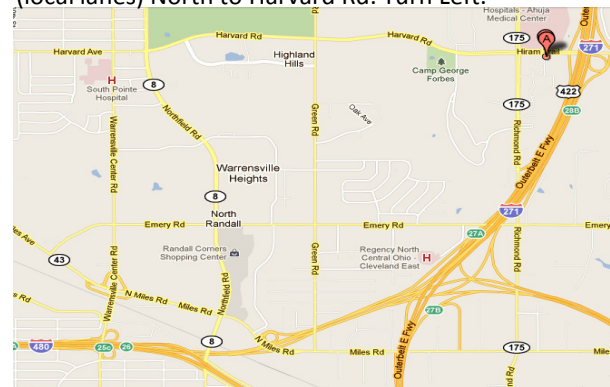
Directions and Map

From points East: (Pittsburgh, Youngstown): Take Ohio turnpike (I-80) West to 187/Exit 13. Take I-480 West to I-271 (local lanes) North to Harvard Rd. Turn left.

From points West: (IL, IN, MI): Take the Ohio Turnpike (I-80) East and follow to Exit 151. Then follow I-480 East to 1-271 (local lanes) North to Harvard Rd. Turn Left.

From points South: (Columbus): Take I-71 North to I-271 (local lanes) North to Harvard Rd. Turn Left.
