

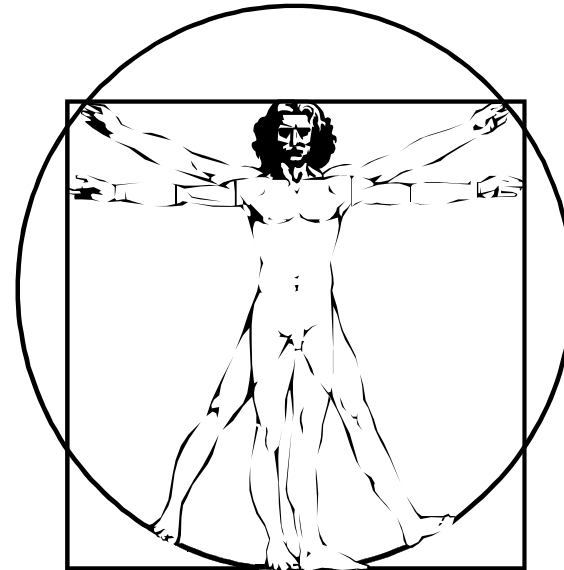

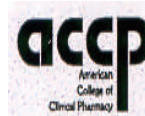

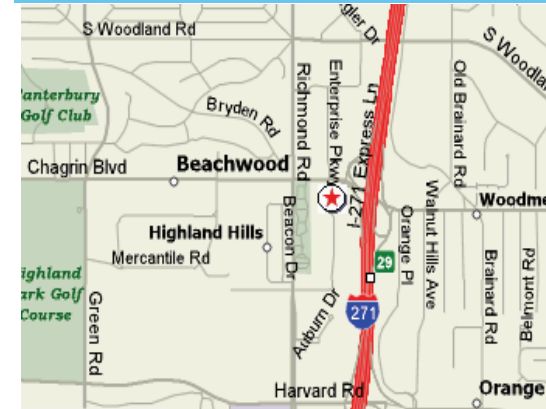

**From Points East** (Pittsburgh, Youngstown): Take the Ohio Turnpike (I-80) West and follow to 187/Exit 13. Take I-480 West to I-271 (local lanes) North to Chagrin Blvd. Turn Left and follow to first street which is Park East Drive and turn Left.
